

Transitional Arrangements in respect of 1960 Act Allegations

Article 5 of The Health Professions Order 2001 (Transitional Provisions) Order of Council 2003 provides that where:

- an allegation was received by the HPC between 1st April 2002 and 9th July 2003;
- notice of inquiry in respect of that allegation has been served on the registrant; but
- the inquiry into that allegation has not begun;

then the Council, with the agreement of the registrant, shall refer the allegation to the appropriate Practice Committee for it to be dealt with under Part V and Article 38 of the Health Professions Order 2001 but subject to appropriate modifications made by Article 2 of the Order of Council 2003.

Council is asked to delegate to the Registrar the function of referring cases in such circumstances by means of the following resolution:

RESOLVED That the functions of the Council under Article 5(2) of the Health Professions Order 2001 (Transitional Provisions) Order of Council 2003 be delegated to the Registrar SUBJECT TO the Registrar reporting from time to time to the Council on the exercise of those functions.
