



That the education provider and its programmes remained approved.
Monitoring period
2 years (academic year 2022-23)
Reasons
<p>The Panel accepted the visitor’s recommendation that the education provider and its programmes remain approved, for the reasons noted below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Following documentary review and quality activity, the visitors were broadly satisfied across the areas reflected upon in the portfolio submission. There were no major risks to the education provider’s approach to meeting the standards, which indicates adherence to standards and performance above our regulatory threshold. • The panel noted the lack of certain data points within the portfolio, and it was agreed that the Executive would work with the provider to establish ongoing data points. <p>They also agreed with the visitors’ recommended monitoring period, for the reasons noted below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This date for next portfolio submission will give the education provider a sufficient interval in which to follow through the programme and staff development intentions outlined through the quality activity, and for those changes to have had a sufficient period to become integrated into the programme when the HCPC next undertake a performance review. It will also enable them to establish ongoing data reporting to the HCPC, should they wish to.
